Information and Expression of Interest for Catering Providers

The sixth annual Yungaburra Triathlon will draw participants and spectators to the picturesque Atherton Tablelands in Far North Queensland to experience the best our region has to offer.

As the event is focused on health and wellness, catering providers are asked to consider healthy food and beverage options. The Healthy Eating Advisory Service's [Simple changes for healthier catering](#) provides guidance around the provision of healthier choices. Preference will be given to local providers and those offering healthy options. This is an alcohol-free event.

The Yungaburra Triathlon course takes in the World Heritage Wet Tropics Rainforest and the local area is a key agricultural region. Sustainability is important to the Yungaburra Triathlon and we will continue to implement initiatives that demonstrate our focus on being a sustainable event. We ask our caterers to take the following into consideration:

- Use of biodegradable products
 - Either 100% recyclable or biodegradable products
 - No use of Palm oil
 - No plastic straws
- Use of local Atherton Tableland produce where available

The Yungaburra Triathlon presents an excellent opportunity for catering providers to access a large audience. Catering providers will be located within the triathlon area at the Tinaburra Foreshore and are required to be self-sufficient including own power source and water. There is a \$50 flat fee.

Road closures will be in place on Saturday afternoon and Sunday morning and early afternoon. Catering providers will need to arrive before the roads close and stay until they reopen. There will be security onsite on Saturday night. Bump-in is 11:00am Saturday and 5:00am on Sunday. Bump-out is 1:30pm on Sunday.
