



## 4 & 5 April 2020 Tinaburra Foreshore, Yungaburra

### Information and Expression of Interest for Catering Providers

The Yungaburra Triathlon will be held on 5 April 2020 and will provide an opportunity for competitors to compete in a different event Triathlon on the picturesque foreshore of Lake Tinaroo. The Afghanistan Avenue of Honour at Tinaburra provides a fitting backdrop for competitors who help raise funds for Australian soldiers who are physically or psychologically wounded. In its sixth year, the Triathlon draws together competitors from across the local and state triathlon network to participate in this high quality event. We expect up to 2,000 competitors and spectators attending this event over the course of the weekend.

Tablelands Regional Council, in partnership with an organising committee, will again be organising and hosting this successful event.

Road closures will be in place on Sunday morning and early afternoon. It is a requirement that catering providers will arrive onsite before the road closures are to start and stay on site until the roads are reopened. The race check-in will be open on Saturday afternoon and caterers are welcome to start trading on Saturday. There will be security on site on Saturday night. **Saturday Bump-in: 1.00pm. Sunday bump-in: 5.00am / Bump-out: 3.30pm.**

As the event is focused on health and wellness, catering providers are asked to consider healthy food and beverage options. An information sheet from the Healthy Eating Advisory Service '[Simple changes for healthier catering](#)' provides guidance around providing healthier choices. Preference will be given to local food providers and those providing healthy food options.

As the Yungaburra Triathlon is held in the World Heritage Wet Tropics Rainforest and the local area is a key agricultural region which produces food for the nation sustainability is important to the Yungaburra Triathlon. For 2020 the focus will continue to implement new initiatives that demonstrate our focus on being a sustainable event. We therefore ask for our caterers to take the following into consideration:

- Use of biodegradable products
  - Either 100% recyclable or biodegradable products
  - No use of Pam oil
  - No plastic straws
- Use of local Atherton Tableland produce where available

The Triathlon presents an excellent opportunity for catering providers to access a large Tablelands audience. There is a **\$50 flat fee for catering providers** to host a stall at the event. All food and beverage providers are required to be self-sufficient including own power source and water.
